

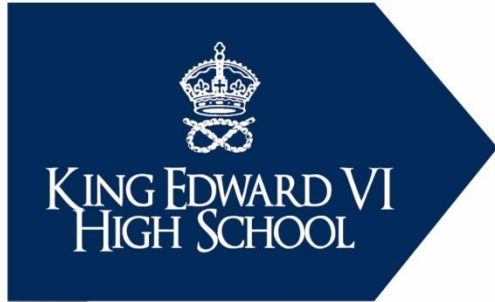

Citizenship

Citizenship

Citizenship is taught throughout the Tutorial programme at King Edward VI High School from Year 7 to Year 13.

In Year 7 pupils explore topics such as 'What is Citizenship?', Local Democracy and Conflict, and are involved with an Active Citizenship project with the charity LEPR. We are also involved with the Road Safety campaign.

In Year 8 pupils study the topics of Crime, Government and Voting as well as Emotional Health and Alcohol.

In Year 9 pupils explore Diversity, Human Rights, the EU and the United Nations. They are involved in a Homeless project and also explore issues around drugs and mental health.

Pupils continue to explore Citizenship issues during Tutorial in Year 10 and Year 11. They explore topics such as Financial Literacy, Gambling, Government issues and Politics.

In Years 8-10 pupils can volunteer to be Hear 4 U buddies. They undergo 8 weeks of training and then join Year 7 pupils in the morning to offer support and help.
