Dear Parents/Guardians

This May, Staffordshire County Council, through funding from the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP), will be providing each individual eligible child a £15.00 eVoucher for the May Half Term Holidays 2021. To be eligible the child must meet the criteria listed below and attend a Staffordshire education setting:

- In receipt of benefits-related Free School Meals
- In receipt of Universal Infant Free School Meals but will be eligible for benefits-related Free School Meal
- Children receiving Think2 or Early Years Pupil Premium funding

Before the end of this term, you will receive a link directly from the education setting where your child attends, once you click on the link you will be able to select an eVoucher from a supermarket of your choice. You will be able choose from Aldi, ASDA, Morrisons, Tesco, Sainsburys, Marks & Spencer or Waitrose. Your eVoucher bar code will then be displayed on-screen and can be downloaded. If you do not have access to a phone or email, the education setting will be able to collect your eVoucher on your behalf by accessing your child/s link.
